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DESCRIPTION: Create a Keynote/iMovie presentation that highlights the best work that you have created this year. (Minimum of 15 works required) The presentation will include images of your work as well as words to explain your progress. You can speak during the presentation, put the words on the slides or record your voice and play the presentation. The work from second semester should be highlighted and comprise a significant amount of the show/presentation. This Presentation may include all the works in your final exhibit plus others that don't fit in the exhibit. See details below. It should also include a section with 3 photos of your installed exhibit. These can be overall exhibit views of your board or close-ups of details that stand out in your opinion (i.e. fancy design of your name) NO GOOGLE PRESENTATIONS!!!!

Organization:	15 points	
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Divide the presentation in a way that makes sense and shows what you have accomplished and explored.

- I. For example if you have done a lot of still life and collage work you might have slides that show still life, the progression through that subject and then collage and the progression through it.
- 2. You could organize the way the AP portfolio is organized: Breadth, Concentration and Quality.
- 3. You could also organize your work chronologically from the beginning of the year to present.

Written Requirements: 30 points _____ (you need to hand in a printed paper along with presentation)

Discuss the following in words either on the slides or aloud as you present.

- 1. Explain how the collection of work you've chosen demonstrates your growth as an artist in terms of the three Cs: concept (idea development), craftsmanship (use of media) and compositions (overall design of 2 or 3 dimensional space). This is a summary of your growth and development as an artist. Use your works as examples, but don't re-critique each piece.
- 2. Explain the creative or innovative approach you used to make your work unique and interesting, while still meeting the criteria for each assignment.
- 3. Tell which of the elements and principles of design the artworks illustrate and how they do this. Again this is in summary, not piece by piece.
- 4. What was the most useful or helpful thing you learned from the work you've created and the class journey we took.

Use the colors and fonts and create your own design that matches your work and highlights your talents as a designer. If you know animation software and want to do a fancy flash animated version of your portfolio go for it! I know you're so ready for summer....but be proud and do something beautiful! MACLABSHARE DRIVE DIGITAL PORTFOLIO: 20 points_____

You must also have a completed your MAC LAB SHARE drive folder containing all 24 works of art for Breadth and Concentration. These should be high resolution (300 dpi) jpgs.

- 1. One folder with your First and Last name on it.
- 2. Breadth Folder inside name folder with all 12 Breadth pieces (more if you had extras, make a folder called Breadth Extras)
- 3. One folder inside Name folder called Concentration with all 12 Concentration pieces (more if you had extras, make a folder called Concentration Extras)
- 4. Each image is 300 dpi and at least 3×5 inches large.
- 5. Images are edited with Photoshop Levels to get maximum contrast and exposure
- 6. Images are cropped so that no clutter or extra background stuff appears, only your art.
- 7. Images are named as follows: yourname-con Lipg or yourname-bre Lipg
- 8. A digital copy of your exam presentation and paper is in the folder.

- 1. Please make sure you have taken down your exhibit on exam day after the exam.
- 2. Please make sure you've cleaned out all of the shelves, palettes, brushes and other supplies you've used all year.
