## Assignment Description: Combine 3 Texture

Using the images we shot outside and in the art studio combine a minimum of three images to create one final digital image. The final image should show evidence that you have changed 10 things from the original main image. These changes could include copying and pasting new imagery in, color adjustments, clone stamping things in or out of your image, working with levels or curves to adjust contrast or applying filters (use these sparingly).

## GRADING SCALE: Point Value

- + Plus indicates you did this well and counts for 3 points
- $\sqrt{\phantom{0}}$  Check indicates that you did this, but were missing something and counts for 2 points
- Minus indicates that you did not do this to the level required and counts for I point
- 0 Zero indicates that the required element is missing and counts for 0 points

Specifics:
Combined 3 images into one unified image, with convincing subject matter
Changed 10 things from the original images
Edges of selections are convincing and real
Final image has convincing lighting and shading
Focus of images are sharp and clear, with subject in full focus
Image was clearly thought out and uses at least one of the five compositional techniques.
(framing, leading lines, rule of thirds, fill the frame, level horizon, intersting point of view)
Uploaded 4 images or more to wiki, including originals and final
Image resolution was changed to 72 or 150 dpi so page loads quickly.
Wrote an explanation of the 10 changes you made to create a final Combined 3 Image and posted to the wiki page with images.
Explained which compositional technique you used in the main photograph.
Described the texture you emphasized
Explained how and what elements and principles of design were used in your work.
Images were named and saved into the proper folder on the Share Drive (lastnameorig I.jpg, lastnameorig 2.jpg and lastnameorig 3.jpg and lastnamefinal.jpg)
