

Gene Frett Visual Arts Scholarship Application Cover Sheet and Instructions

The Pewaukee High School Visual Arts Scholarship was founded in 2007 to offer scholarships to promising PHS artists to enable their pursuit of excellence in the visual arts at the college level. In 2012 a generous donation by Terry and Lauree Frett in honor of Terry's dad Gene was made; thus renaming the scholarship. Gene Frett worked for Binney-Smith selling art supplies to classroom teachers. The scholarship came under the umbrella of the Pewaukee Scholarship Fund with this donation and renaming. In 2014 the Frett family donated an additional amount to the fund to raise the annual scholarship to \$1500.00. The scholarship continues to support the studies of Pewaukee High School Visual Art students looking to continue their pursuit of excellence at the college level.

4. The artist statement as described here
5. Letter of Recommendation as described here
6. List of non-PHS outside art classes or other art related experiences
7. Information about your involvement in art club (if you were not in art club you can still apply, but preference will be given to art club members)
8. Your official high school transcript. Submit signature sheet to the PHS School Counselor office and they will forward transcripts to us.
9. One senior portrait with name printed on the back to be used in newspaper announcements.
10. A copy of the college acceptance letter where you intend to study art, art therapy art education, design (architectural, fashion, interior, graphic, etc.) or art history

Visual Arts Scholarship Guidelines

Academic Year 2014-15

Section B

Student will need to submit the following items to apply and be considered for the scholarship:

- The attached application-section A
- Current official transcript of all course work with art courses taken at PHS highlighted. Students will not be considered for this scholarship unless they have taken at least 2 full credits (years) in art during their high school career.
- List of additional classes taken outside of PHS that relate to student's art abilities and knowledge. (This could include pre-college courses at MIAD, park and recreation center courses in arts and crafts or other high school level experiences)
- Two letters of recommendation from an adult other than a family member who knows your artwork and can recommend your abilities as a student artist.
- A one-page artist statement (word processed) which includes the following:
 - Discuss the elements and principles of design as illustrated in your work
 - Explain how you have implemented the 3 Cs of quality artwork (craftsmanship, concept and composition)
 - Conclude by explaining the studies you hope to pursue with this scholarship should you receive it.
- The portfolio should include 8-10 works that best illustrate the student artist's abilities and artistic direction. The portfolio must include one self-portrait and one still life. The portfolio can show examples in any media. The portfolio will consist of photographs of artwork and must be turned in digitally on a cd or dvd.
 - Digital images should be saved on a disc (cd not flash drives) as jpegs for easy viewing. Label the images as: last name first four letters_ Image 1, Image 2 etc.
 - Example your last name is Smith: smit_image 1
 - Submit a corresponding title sheet that lists the image titles and corresponding numbers, the media used to complete the work and the size of the original work (without frame/mat).
 - Example:
 - smit_image 1 "Self Portrait in Blue", Acrylic Painting, 16" x 20"
