Assignment Description - Perspective: Illusion of Space

Create several drawings that illustrate your understanding of two-point perspective and the use of it to create the illusion of 3-dimensional space in 2-dimensional media. In the final free choice drawing creatively add a twist to make the drawing your own, while showing 2 point or 3 point perspective through line only.

Specifics: Classwork Assessed at 70% of Total Quarter Grade

- Work must be a 18 x 24
- Work must be done in a choice of media including: marker, pencil or ink
- Strong composition and design should be evident
- Remember the 3 Cs: composition, concept and craftsmanship
- Work must show accurate 2-point perspective and a realistic/possible view of the objects drawn
- Work must show a strong focal point: Subject of drawing
- Work must show an interesting, meaningful and purposeful break-up of space
- Work must show an awareness of positive and negative spaces
- Work must be completed in the time frame given and meet all deadlines
- Final collection should include:
 - o Ten 2-point perspective boxes drawn on newsprint (half sheets)
 - o Ten 1-point perspective boxes drawn on newsprint (half sheets)
 - o One 2-point perspective line drawing done from observation in the school cafeteria/library/outside or at home if you missed the class.
 - o 2-point perspective line drawing done from observation in the classroom or your own photo for reference only. This drawing should be fully detailed using line, no shading. Finished in pencil & ink.

Sketchbook Requirements: Assessed at 15% of Quarter Grade

- Develop a full-page written brainstorm of ideas you could do a perspective drawing of. Think “outside the box” for these. City scenes are ok, but how could you go farther, make it different, make it your own.
- Develop 6-8 thumbnails to plan your perspective drawing.

If you want to improve your skills complete the following:

- Sketch a corner of your room, garage, basement or other area of your house that is cluttered and messy and shows 2-point perspective.
