Remember that your presentation should be reflective of your work as a whole. Don't talk about every single piece, rehashing what has already been said in critique. Instead look at your development as an artist and reflect on which pieces helped you get to this point.

 - _____ Explain the creative or innovative approach you used to make your work unique and interesting, while still meeting the criteria for each assignment.
 - _____ Tell which of the elements and principles of design the artworks illustrate and how.
 - _____ What was the most useful or helpful thing you learned from the work you've created

Design:

- _____ You are an artist! Don't just use the boring PowerPoint backgrounds. BE CREATIVE Consider using music or spoken word or smart builds to create a better design. Consider using iMovie and making it a movie, stopmotion, animation etc.
 - _____ Use the colors and fonts and your own images to create your own design that matches your work and highlights your talents as a photographer.

Share Drive Folder:
