SORT ITEMS BY COLOR GROUPS: PRIMARY, SECONDARY, OR WARM/COOL



SEARCH FOR A SHAPE THROUGHOUT YOUR HOME. DRAW OR CREATE A PHOTO COLLAGE



GO ON A TEXTURE HUNT. FIND, DRAW, AND LABEL ALL THE TEXTURES YOU FIND.



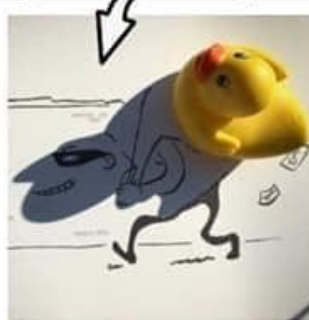

TAKE A PHOTO OF AN OBJECT AND ITS SHADOW. TURN THE SHADOW INTO A DRAWING.




CREATE A COMIC SHOWING A BEGINNING, MIDDLE, AND END OF A STORY.

Draw someone in your house from observation, it can be you if you'd like! Experiment with your materials, and add a background that tells a story about your subject.	Draw 6 different sketches of a project(s) you'd love to make when we get back to school. Take your time! Push your creativity and skills!	Watch 'Rivers and Tides' (look it up!) the make a piece of art outdoors like Andy Goldsworthy. Remember not to damage anything, and take great photos when done!
Research Origami. Find a fold you would like to create and fold at least 15 examples. Be creative and think outside the box - combine these into one finished piece	Use 3, 5 or 7 items of different sizes and heights to create a still life. Set it up in a window with natural light. Paint or draw from observation focusing on form and value	Who is one artist you always wanted to learn more about? Do some research about them. Write a short paper about what you learned and create a piece of art in their style	Covid-19 is changing our world overnight, and it is very surreal. Create a piece that captures your feelings and thoughts in this moment in history.	Find a pen. Use it to make a drawing. Keep layering until you run out of ink. Do not fear the dark side! Find balance within the force.
Develop cartoon characters that represent you and a few friends or family. Create a finished piece that depicts these characters interacting.	Use paper (can be old mail, newspapers, etc) to create a sculpture. Research different methods and artists that have worked with simple paper as a medium		Research 'Op-Art' or 'Pop-Art'. Write a paragraph about that movement, then make a piece of artwork that fits within that movement.	Use collage to make a dynamic landscape. Draw or paint into your collage. Focus on building texture, creating the illusion of depth and color scheme.
Practice drawing your hand from multiple perspectives in multiple positions. Use tutorials if you need help. Then, create a finished piece based what you've learned.	Look through past projects you've made. Find one you loved and make another piece inspired by it. Focus on creating a high quality piece.	Make a self portrait in any style and medium of your choosing. Capture an important part of your personality, life experiences, or mood.	Find an artist you love who works in the materials your current class is in. Write a short paper about the artist. Create a piece of art inspired by their work.	Research Fauvism. Make a drawing or painting of your pet in this style. Fill the entire page with your composition (little to no negative space) focus on texture and color use.
Research how to make your own pigments from plant or vegetable matter. Make your own pigment, then create a piece of art from it.	Use toilet paper and paper towel rolls and other found cardboard to make an abstract sculpture. Work occupied and unoccupied space (look it up if you need to)	Surprise me! Come up with your own great prompt and then share it with the class in our google classroom discussion on Yay Art Bingo, then make a piece based on the prompt.	Research how to make paper from recycled papers, then make some! Use those papers to make a sculpture or collage.	Research Alexander Calder. Create a mobile in any style you would like from any materials you would like.
