GPA, recognitions and community service may also be used to judge applicants. PAAC will have sole responsibility for determining eligibility, selection of recipients and its decision will be final. PAAC reserves the right to cancel or modify the scholarship. Recipients will be notified by mail or phone. Void where prohibited. All federal, state, local laws and regulations apply.
